In Fall 2024, the University of Pikeville undergraduate program enrolled 1,137 students from 34 states and 29 foreign countries. For the cohort of all first-time, full-time freshmen who entered the University of Pikeville in Fall 2023, 68 percent returned to UPIKE in Fall 2024.

## Estimated Loan Indebtedness upon Graduation

72% of the baccalaureate Class of 2024 who entered UPIKE as a first-time freshman borrowed at any time through any loan programs (institutional, state, Federal Perkins, Federal Stafford Subsidized and Unsubsidized, private loans that were certified by UPIKE; excluding parent loans). This includes both Federal Direct Student Loans and Federal Family Education Loans. The average per-undergraduate-borrower cumulative principal borrowed was \$28,251.
