Each Summer Instructor will be expected to design, instruct, and document participant development and attendance in class. Selected candidates must commit to the projects, policies, including absolutely no dating of participants, confidentiality, proper referral procedures, and possess the ability to exemplify and demonstrate professional etiquette and demeanor.

Successful candidates will have a baccalaureate degree with secondary certification or a specialty certification in the area for which they are applying. Successful candidates must demonstrate experiences that will allow them to identify with the barriers and disadvantages of target area participants. Selected candidates will demonstrate exceptional motivation and commitment toward supplementing participant's academic experience. Successful candidates will demonstrate behavior suitable for a role model, academic strength useful to the participants and the desire and abilities for a mentoring relationship.

Important Notes: Resume and other application materials will be reviewed to determine if you meet the required qualifications for the position. If it is determined that you meet the required qualifications, your application materials will be used to identify a top group of the most highly qualified candidates. Please, specifically address the qualifications, competencies and desired qualifications in your resume and application materials.
